Safeway puts 'Us''' in Community



At Thanksgiving and Christmas, Safeway was able to donate to Families Plus to the tune of more than 80 complete turkey

dinners, including frozen turkey breasts, mashed potatoes, gravy, stuffing and dinner rolls.

Borens delivered the goods himself and our Parent Partners helped families receive that bounty





to enrich their lives and show them how much the Delta community cares. Families Plus isn't the only recipient of the community's good will.

Safeway also makes sure those who find themselves at the local shelter also get a great meal.
