Integrated Care Update

Becky Ela, MSW, LCSW Behavior Professional

Families Plus' Behavior Health Specialists continue to provide integrated care in Delta County primary care offices. Susan Simianer, LPC and Betsy Nordstrom, LPC can be found at Delta County Family Practice in Delta. Becky Ela, LCSW, sees patients at Stoney Mesa Family Practice, Delta County Family Practice in Hotchkiss, and beginning in January, at Delta Health and Wellness.

From May 1, 2016 through October 31, 2016, we have seen 134 unduplicated patients. Sessions with our patients vary from seeing them once or twice to more sessions for behavior interventions (improving poor sleep, making diet and exercise changes or changing patterns with smoking tobacco and/or other substances). We work with patients who have concerns with their mood (anxiety, depression, bipolar disorder) and other life events (ongoing health issues, grief/bereavement, multiple life stressors).

We are in the second year of our three-year grant. We are looking ahead to renewing our federal grant that provides this integrated care opportunity through the Federal Office of Rural Health Care Policy. We will begin writing this grant in the fall of 2017 and are currently reaching out to other stakeholders in the community. Stay tuned as things are shifting and changing in our rapidly changing health care world!


